

[Native brings music video shoot to Chowchilla](#)

Part of the Brooks and Dunn music video “Indian Summer” was shot at Chowchilla High School’s football stadium last week, reported the Merced Sun-Star newspaper.

The sequence featured football players from rivals Dos Palos and Chowchilla lining up at the line of scrimmage during a game with Chowchilla’s quarterback running it in for a 20-yard touchdown.

For the scene expected to last 10 seconds, it took about four hours to shoot.

Country stars Kix Brooks and Ronnie Dunn filmed their parts in Tennessee, but the football game scene was filmed in Chowchilla at the behest of director Shawn Silva, a native of Chowchilla. His father owns Bob Silva Ford.

The video for “Indian Summer” features a “Romeo and Juliet” kind of storyline featuring a boy and girl who attend rival high schools falling in love.

Professional actors played the main roles in the story, football hero Jake and cheerleader Stacy, but Chowchilla and Dos Palos locals served as extras in the shoot.

A release date for the video has not been announced.
