## Children's Hospital picks Turner to manage addition and renovation

- **Will expand emergency and trauma departments**
- **Adds four operating suites**

Turner Construction Company has been selected to manage a \$42.5 million construction project at Children's Hospital Central California in Madera.

The scope of work includes a 59,531 square foot addition to the Central Valley hospital as well as a 17,306 square foot renovation of the hospital.

The addition will include expansion of the emergency and trauma departments, four operating suites, imaging department expansion, outdoor helipad and support space. Completion is scheduled for January 2012.

Turner Construction Company is a unit of HOCHTIEF Aktiengesellschaft (FWB: HOT), Germany's largest construction company.

Children's Hospital Central California is a 338-bed, not-for-profit children's hospital on a 50-acre campus with a medical staff of more than 450 physicians. It says it treats more inpatient cases than any pediatric hospital north of San Diego, making it the second largest children's hospital in the state and one of the 10 largest hospitals of its type in the nation.
