The new 7,750 square-foot Center for Advanced Manufacturing was officially dedicated today at the Madera Community College Center.

The new building will be home to the newly developed maintenance mechanic program, which includes courses in welding, hydraulics, pneumatics, electrical motor control and wiring. Students earn a certificate as a maintenance mechanic at the conclusion of the program.

The courses began last fall. They are geared toward students looking for a short-term, one semester job readiness training program, said Terry Kershaw, vice chancellor of the north centers.
